

## **Mimiko pays condolence visit to family of late Ondo Local Government Service Commission boss**

Ondo State Governor, Dr. Olusegun Mimiko yesterday (Monday) paid a condolence visit to the family house of the late Chairman of the State Local Government Service Commission, Alhaji Yesiru Oladele at his Ijapo Estate residence in Akure, the state capital.

Dr. Mimiko was accompanied by his Chief of Staff, Dr Kola Ademujimi, the State Commissioner for Lands and Housing, Alhaji Sikiru Basaru and his Natural Resources counterpart, Mr Remi Olatubura.
