

Mimiko condoles with Owo people over the death of State Chairman of Local Government Service Commission

The Ondo State Governor, Dr Olusegun Mimiko has expressed shock over the untimely death of the Chairman of the State Local Government Service Commission, Alhaji Yesiru Oladele who passed away yesterday (Sunday).

Oladele, a Lawyer was one of the legal luminaries who fought for the retrieval of the stolen mandate of Governor Mimiko during the 22-month legal tussles at both the Election Petition Tribunal, Akure and the Court of Appeal in Benin before he was appointed as the Chairman of the Local Government Service Commission until he suddenly died in his Akure home on Sunday.

Governor Mimiko in a Statement signed on his behalf by his Chief Press Secretary, Mr. Kolawole Olabisi stated: "I have just received with utmost shock the sudden death of Alhaji Yesiru Oladele at his home this morning. This is a sad loss and I am short of words to describe how shocked I am because he was such an energetic young man, dedicated, hardworking and had made a lot of landmark achievements in the Local Government Service Commission in so short a time he took charge as Chairman.

I want to sincerely say how sorry I am over this sudden death of this youngman and I want to condole his immediate family and the entire Oladele Family of Owo over this irreparable loss.

Yesiru will be missed by all as we had high hopes that he was destined for greater heights before this unfortunate incident occurred
