

Mimiko commiserates with CJN, sends powerful delegation to Benue

Ondo State Governor, Dr Olusegun Mimiko has commiserated with the Chief Justice of Nigeria (CJN), Justice Aloysius Katsina-Alu over the demise of his wife, Mrs. Mimi Victoria Katsina-Alu saying that by the unfortunate incident, the Chief Judge had lost a confidant and dependable companion.
