

Mimiko flags off N4.8 billion Ikare-Akoko Ajowa road... commissions 210 Ikare regional market

Ondo State Governor, Dr Olusegun Mimiko on Wednesday break over break a 30-year old jinx as he flagged off the long abandoned Ikare- Akoko -Ajowa- road at a whopping cost of N4.8 billion. Similarly, Governor Mimiko commissioned the largest market in Ondo State, the Ikare Regional market built at a cost of N210 million.

The two key projects were part of the activities marking his administration's second anniversary as his spate of projects commissioning took his train to Akoko in the Northern Senatorial District of the State.

The Ikare-Ajowa road is an all important road that links the State with Kogi State and other Northern State and has been abandoned for ages.

While flagging off the 29.40 km road project, Governor Mimiko told the people of Akoko that the project would is expected to be completed within 27 dry months.
