

ONDO CONDEMNS UN BOMB BLAST

The Ondo State Government yesterday condemned the bomb blast which damaged the United Nations (UN) building in Abuja early on Friday describing it as not only reprehensible but antithetical of all sane reasoning.

In a release issued by the Chief Press Secretary to the State Governor, Mr. Kolawole Olabisi, the State government while expressing dismay at the spate of bombing in the country sympathised with the families of the victims, the UN officials adding that no efforts must be spared to arrest the perpetrator of such dastardly act.

“On behalf of the Government and people of Ondo State, the State Governor, Dr Olusegun Mimiko, sympathise with the families and officials of the United Nations over the bomb blast that occurred today in its Abuja office complex. We condemn this act of terrorism as unacceptable, anachronistic, retrogressive, reprehensible, odious, barbaric and against the commandment of God to shed lives and destroy property at will for base reasoning.

“While we urge all security agencies to ensure that the perpetrators are brought to book, we commiserated with the, those injured, their families and the federal government over this unfortunate and unacceptable incident. It is one dastardly act too many.”

The release further assured that all hands were on deck in Ondo State to ensure that the lasting peace being enjoyed in Ondo State since the inception of the Olusegun Mimiko administration was sustained. It further added that all security apparatus in the State had been put on red alert to ensure that no breach of security is entertained.
